

The successful candidate must meet the established requirements of each phase in the testing process in order to proceed to the next phase:

- Physical Assessment: The Police Officer Physical Aptitude Test (POPAT). *See Additional information below
- Written Assessment *See additional information below
- Oral Board Assessment
- Background Investigation
- Polygraph Examination
- Psychological Examination
- Medical Examination Drug Screening/Eye/Hearing

*Candidates that have tested with the Sahuarita Police Department and passed POPAT and written assessment within the last 6 months are eligible to move to and participate in the oral boards, but must still complete the Town of Sahuarita Application and AZPOST Application.

BENEFITS

The salary range is \$48,484.80 - \$70,324.80 with a generous benefit package including paid vacation, sick leave and holidays. The town pays 100% of employee medical, dental and life insurance. - Notarized AZPOST Background with all required attachments
 - ✓ High School Diploma or GED
 - ✓ DD-214 (if applicable)
 - ✓ Certificate of birth or other verification of citizenship
 - ✓ Police officer candidates must be a minimum of 21 years old at the time of graduation from the police academy.
 - ✓ Candidates must have a driver's licenses at the time of appointment

 - ✓ No photocopies or previously completed AZPOST backgrounds will be accepted.
 - ✓ No emails or facsimiles will be accepted.
