

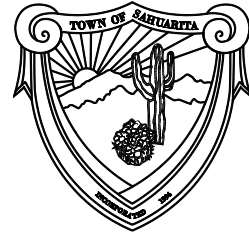

## Single Family Residence from Model Plan Submittal Checklist

The following items are required and submittals must be complete before accepted for review.

- Submit Application Online** <https://aca.accela.com/TOS/Default.aspx>
  - Create user profile online, directions on website
  - Complete all information and submit all of the following required documents on website
  
- Site Plan (PDF)**
  - Site plan with model number, elevation and options
  - Provide address and subdivision name
  - Site area square footage must be shown
  - Show location of proposed residence, walls and utilities
  - Provide the nearest upstream manhole elevation, the finish floor elevation and state if a backwater valve is required or not on the site plan
  - Sidewalks and driveways must be shown. Indicate square footage
  - Setbacks, easements must be marked on all sides of property
  - For all lots that are not mass graded, the following is required:
    - Show grading limits
    - Show total grading square footage of all improvements
    - A Type I Grading Permit (including permit checklist items) is needed if the development envelope is 14,000 square feet or greater; or for clearing, brushing or grubbing of an area of less than 14,000 sq ft. Submit drawings directly to Public Works for grading plan approval.
  
- Wastewater Utility Fee Permit (PDF)**, if connected to Pima County's sewer system

### Notes:

- A model plan permit must be approved by the Town of Sahuarita Planning and Building Department before a site plan permit will be issued.
- Model homes open to the public require a zoning clearance for the model complex site plan. Please contact Planning & Zoning at 520-822-8855 for further assistance.
- If special inspections are required, the special inspection registrant must be on the Town of Sahuarita's approved list on website.
- Fire sprinkler requirements are based on the fire flow for the subdivision per 2018 International Fire Code section Table B105.1.
- During construction, fire flow and fire access are required before combustible materials are permitted on site.
